- 1. The Foundation Main Council.
- 2. The Foundation Council.
- 3. The Board of the Foundation.

The Foundation Main Council.

§23

The Foundation Main Council is a consultative and advisory body. The Foundation Main Council propagates the aims, for which the realization of the Foundation was created.

§24

- 1. The Foundation Main Council is created from the totality of its Founders.
- Other members of the Foundation can become physical persons and representatives of legal persons who support the Foundation organizationally, in essence, or material-related matters.
- 3. The resolution about extending the composition of the Foundation Main Council is taken by the Foundation Main Council with a simple majority of votes in the presence of at least the half of the Foundation Main Council members.

§25

- The membership in the Foundation Main Council expires in case of death of a physical person, declaring bankruptcy or liquidation of a legal person, or dismissing its makeup.
- 2. Dismissing a member of the Foundation Main Council ensues as the result of:
 - submitting their resignation,
 - judicial deprivation of public rights or loss of capacity to enter legal transactions,
 - arising circumstances that permanently make it impossible or difficult for a Foundation Main Council member to be in charge of their function or that make a loss of credit to the Foundation Main Council member.
